All students must commence at Level 1

Examinations are held at the end of each short course

(these exams are not compulsory but you can not sit an exam unless you have completed the previous one)

If participating in the examinations you will receive a Certificate and a Report of your achievements

Examinations

Fast Track - advanced dancers can do 2 levels of one style at a time and even one other style

Achievement - You will improve memory retention and gain confidence with the repetition and completion of each level

Safe Dance - these principles are incorporated into all dance styles

Teaching - broaden your general dance vocabulary, obtain teaching qualifications upon completion of Level 5 jazz

SHORT COURSES

All the courses are divided into levels with the duration being approximately 20 weeks each
JAZZ Levels 1 - 8 TAP Levels 1 - 8 CLASSICAL Levels 1- 8

The short courses (DFTA syllabus) have been updated in line with Safe Dance Policies and devised with the aid of professional health practitioners.

They offer many advantages to anyone hoping to improve their standard of dance.

Follow on short courses

Associate Jazz Teachers Exam - this course can be commenced after completing level 5 Jazz

Member Jazz Teachers Exam - this course can be commenced after completing level 8 Jazz

For the beginner dancer

- Gain confidence by repetition
- See gradual achievement through each level of dance.
- A knowledge of the body and dance techniques

For the intermediate/advanced dancer

- Improve dance technique
- Quicken your adaptation of different styles and interpretations
- Obtain teaching qualifications

For the teacher

- A gradual process of teaching from beginners to advanced standards
- The knowledge to teach within the students capabilities
- Exams are held 2 times a year, so you can choose a date that suits your dance school calendar.

Experience and Learn

- ♦ **Standing and Floor Exercises** to improve co-ordination and flexibility
- ♦ **Travelling exercises** to advance spatial awareness, balance and elevation.
- ♦ **Dance Routines** to become skilled at new styles and challenges

Short course dates

The year is divided into 2 semesters. New enrolments will be accepted in both semesters 1 & 2 and can be started up until the 6th week of each semester.

CLASSES AVAILABLE

To satisfactorily achieve in each short course it is necessary to partake in extra general classes each week; these classes will also help maintain your technique, fitness and co-ordination. As you progress into the higher levels you will need to do additional classes to manage with the advancing standard.

- ♦ **Levels 1 - 3 Jazz:** 1 level class and at least 1 general jazz class per week
- Levels 4 - 8 Jazz:** 1 level class and at least 2 general classes per week, 1 jazz and 1 classical
- Level 1 - 3 Tap:** 1 level class and at least 1 tap or jazz class per week
- Levels 4 - 8 Tap:** 1 level class and at least 2 general classes per week, 1 tap and either 1 jazz or classical
- Levels 1 - 3 Classical:** 1 level class and at least 1 classical or jazz class per week
- Levels 4-8 Classical:** 1 level class and at least 2 general classes per week, 1 classical and 1 jazz
