Diploma of Dance and Performance 1st Year

(1 year full time)

For the Advanced dance student: In Diploma of Dance and Performance 1st Year the dance, performance and allied skills are developed, preparing for a high level of professional employment in the industry. Employment opportunities include mainly chorus and ensemble work in dance and cabaret shows in Australia, Asia, Europe, and on cruise ships.

(For International students this course is called Certificate IV in Dance & Performance)

Graduates of Diploma of Dance & Performance 1st year could then undertake further training at the next level:

Diploma of Dance & Performance 2nd and final year

PRE-REQUISITE

Certificate III in Dance or minimum 4 years Jazz training and 2 years Classical training or equivalent.

CURRICULUM

Jazz, Classical, Contemporary, Tap, Performance, Hip Hop, Funk, Vocal Production, Musical Theatre, Acting, Acrobats, Anatomy, Theory, 1 private vocal lesson per term.



Certificate IV in Dance Teaching

(1 year full time)

Perfect for the experienced dancer wanting to gain accredited qualifications for teaching. The course is designed to enable the teaching of correct technique, safe dance awareness, group dynamics and confident teaching skills. Incorporated into the Teaching course is our jazz, tap, hip-hop & classical syllabus which was devised with help from physiotherapists, chiropractors and other physical experts.

Graduates of Certificate IV could then undertake further training at the next level:

Diploma of Dance & Performance 2nd Year

PRE-REQUISITE

Certificate III in Dance or minimum 4 years Jazz training and 2 years Classical training or equivalent.

Diploma of Dance and Performance 2nd Year (1 year full time)

The Diploma of Dance & Performance 2nd Year level further develops dancers, with increased emphasis on performance skills. Graduates may find employment opportunities in dance teaching, choreography, and dance, singing & acting roles. Dance production, choreography, and dance teaching are emphasised to broaden the professional careers of graduates.

PRE-REQUISITE

Diploma of Dance and Performance 1st Year/ Certificate IV in Dance Teaching

Certificate III in Dance

(1 year full time or 2 years part time)

For the Intermediate dance student: Certificate III aims to develop performers in a range of dance and other styles including vocal production, drama and acrobatics.

Previous dance training an advantage but not necessary

Certificate II in Dance

(1 year part time) Day or Evening

Certificate II is perfect for the beginner or intermediate student. This course aims to introduce the dance student to a variety of dance styles and performance skills. This course is not available to International Students.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Australian & International Students

Dance Factory Provider no. 3746 CRICOS Code 01884F

Access to the course is not limited on the basis of gender, social or educational background.

Due to the physical nature of the course and the demands of the commercial dance and musical theatre performance profession, physical ability and appearance are important considerations.

All applicants should have previous dance/movement training, or be able to display a suitable level of physical co-ordination, sensory facility and potential suitability to meet the course requirements.

Admission to the course requires the student to demonstrate sufficient movement ability in an audition class and satisfy the Artistic Director and teaching staff representatives.

LANGUAGE, LITERACY & NUMERACY REQUIREMENTS

In order to complete the course students will need to have basic language, literacy and numeric skills. The skills will need to be sufficient enough to:

- Prepare written assignments
- Prepare and deliver a written journal
- Read basic anatomy and 'principals of practice' literature
- Count to music for timing
- Read and recite scripts and song lyrics

It is expected that **international students** will be functionally literate to the extent required to read, comprehend and discuss course materials. English Language equivalent to an IELTS score of 5.5 or completion of the audition requirements of Dance Factory.

EVIDENCE OF ENGLISH, LANGUAGE, LITERACY & NUMERACY must be provided by:

- ◆ The international student applying must fill out and sign the application form.
- ◆ If auditioning in person, a face to face interview with the student co-ordinator will be conducted.

Or

- ◆ If auditioning by DVD/Video the student must talk to camera in English, stating their name, age, date of birth, where they are from and why they are applying for the course.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are awarded each year. Each scholarship is to the value of \$3000.

Scholarships are only awarded at the main audition day on Saturday 27th August, 2011.

To be awarded a scholarship, Dance Factory would consider students that show potential and exhibit a good attitude.

(International Students are not eligible for scholarships)

AUSTRALIAN STUDENTS APPLYING FOR THE COURSE

1. Complete application and medical form, and attach :
1 full length photo of yourself
1 passport photo attached to application form

3. Applicants will be notified of an audition date and time to be held at the Dance Factory Studios.
(no audition is required for Certificate II applicants)
The first and main audition will be held on Saturday 27th August, 2011. Subsequent auditions will be held throughout the year.
4. Attend audition.
5. Successful applicants will be notified in writing of their acceptance and other relevant course details within 7 days.
6. Applicants will return to Dance Factory the Acceptance of Place form and deposit to confirm their enrolment within 14 days. Fees are payable in advance and are non-refundable.
7. Dance Factory will then forward a Confirmation of Enrolment which will have all your information for financial assistance with the Federal Governments Austudy/Abstudy or Youth Allowance programs, please retain this document for future reference.

AUDITION BY DVD/VIDEO

If not currently in Melbourne, Australia, you may apply by sending a DVD/ Video with your application, medical and application fee for us to assess your skills through practical demonstration of your jazz, classical and/or vocal skills if applicable. Please wear appropriate dance attire so technique and alignment can be assessed accurately, no costumes please.

Perform travelling steps including jetes, kicks - front and side, turns and one Jazz and/or Classical/Contemporary routine, max 2 mins.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS APPLYING FOR FULL TIME COURSES

New students: Application Fee \$100

Existing students: Application Fee \$20

The procedure for applying for the course is the same as for Australian students **except for steps 6 and 7**. Only students 18 years and over can apply.

- International students will need to send the appropriate fees within 14 days of acceptance with their Acceptance of Place Offer form. **Students have the choice of paying per semester or by the year. Fees are payable in advance and are non-refundable.**
- Dance Factory will then forward a Confirmation of Enrolment.
- You should then apply for a student visa at the Australian Consulate, Embassy, High Commission or Australian Education Centre in your home country. Allow 6 - 8 weeks for processing.

International students can **AUDITION IN PERSON or by DVD/VIDEO** following the criteria stated for Australian students. Please read Language, Literacy & Numeracy requirements section.

STUDENT VISA REQUIREMENTS

You need to think about the procedures you will need to follow and the likelihood of obtaining a student visa. The Australian diplomatic mission in your home country can give you up to date and detailed information on visa procedures and on the definition of gazetted and non-gazetted countries.

Non-gazetted Countries: People from non-gazetted countries have been identified as being at risk of overstaying their visas. Stricter rules are used to assess their visa applications.

According to the Dept of Immigration, Multicultural and Indigenous Affairs “to be granted a student visa, you must provide evidence that satisfies the assessment factors applicable to you. Assessment factors include your financial ability, English proficiency, likely compliance with the conditions of your visa and any other matters considered relevant to assessing your application”. Additional information on student visa issues is available on DIMIA Internet site on <http://www.immi.gov.au>

- Applicants must clearly show that they are genuine students, can support themselves and have reasons to return home after their studies.
- You will need to apply at the Australian diplomatic mission for a **Preliminary Visa Assessment** before accepting the offer of place at Dance Factory and before paying any of your tuition or other fees.
- Upon receipt of the Pre Visa Approval from the Australian diplomatic mission, you are then required to make payment as specified. It is necessary to forward a copy of the Pre Visa Approval document with the payment.

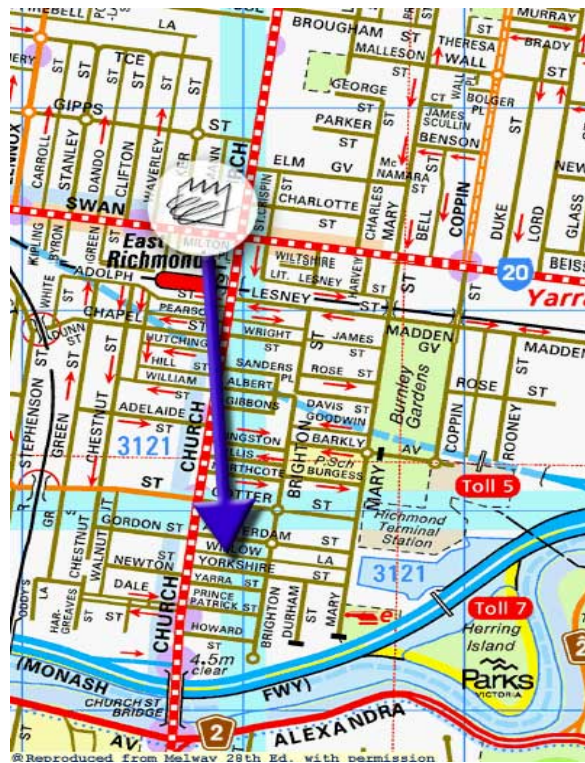
