DFTA in your School

The syllabus is comprised of:

- Preliminary Levels 1-4 (exams for young children aged 6 - 9 in Jazz, Tap, Classical & Funk)
- Levels 1-8 Jazz
- Levels 1-8 Tap
- Levels 1-8 Funk
- Levels 1-8 Classical
- Associate Jazz Teachers Exam
- Members Jazz Teachers Exam

Levels 1—8 are suitable for students 10 years of age through to adults
